Grant Programs

Howard County Arts Council grants are awarded based on artistic merit, ability of the applicant to carry out the project and level of service to the community. Grantees are selected through a competitive process in which applications are reviewed by a volunteer advisory panel made up of academics and artists representing a variety of disciplines. Grant award recommendations are then reviewed and approved by the HCAC Board of Directors. In FY10, HCAC awarded \$346,583 in matching grants to 37 organizations. In addition, a one-time artRelief fund of \$25,000 was awarded to FY10 CAD grant recipients in the Operating category.

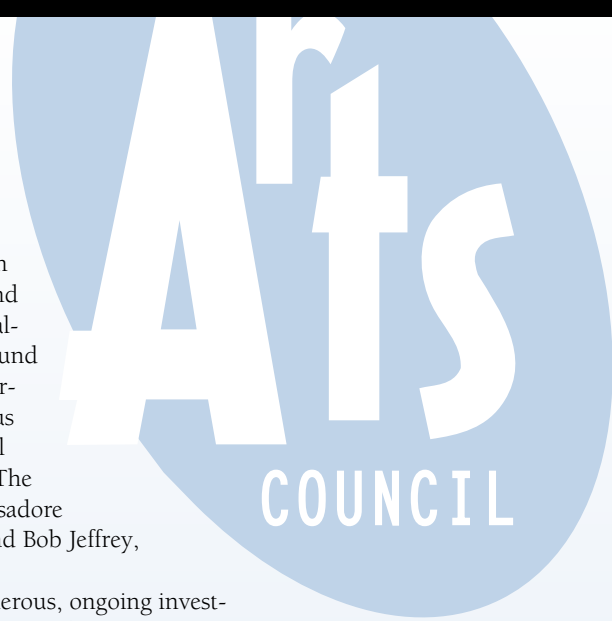

Dear HCAC friends and members,

In FY10 the Arts Council relied—once again—on strong governance along with creative solutions and a dedicated staff to successfully steer through a challenging set of economic woes to end the year on sound financial footing. While contributions fell in some areas, several “angels” stepped forward and provided us with the means to provide the community with a full season of exciting, diverse arts programs—namely The Columbia Bank, The Columbia Foundation, the Isadore and Bertha Gudelsky Family Foundation, Bach and Bob Jeffrey, M&T Bank, and The Rouse Company Foundation.

We are very proud, and thankful, for Howard County’s generous, ongoing investment in the arts community. We are fortunate to have the support of County Executive Ken Ulman and Council members Calvin Ball, Greg Fox, Mary Kay Sigaty, Jen Terresa, and Courtney Watson, who recognize the impact of the arts on economic development, education, tourism and our quality of life. The Maryland State Arts Council maintained a strong level of support and The National Endowment for the Arts renewed its support of Head StART in ART, our model early childhood artist-in-residence program. Equally as important, a host of loyal members and friends stepped forward to bolster our volunteer efforts and to bring contributed and earned income to respectable levels.

This year, with the help of our many supporters, we were able to provide some much needed relief to the hard hit non-profit arts sector. While our non-profit arts groups are used to operating on a shoe-string budget, faced with lower ticket sales and a significant decline in contributions from individuals, foundations and corporations, their already fragile budgets are at great risk. The Arts Council grappled with this issue and was able to create a one-time \$25,000 artRELIEF fund to help alleviate the affect the extended recession has had on the local arts community. Seven Howard County arts organizations received artRELIEF grants: Candlelight Concert Society, Chesapeake Shakespeare Company, Columbia Center for Theatrical Arts, Columbia Festival of the Arts, Columbia Orchestra, Columbia Pro Cantare, and the Howard County Poetry and Literature Society.

In response to artRELIEF, Bruce Kuehne, President of The Columbia Orchestra, wrote “We have been blessed to have the Howard County Arts Council advocating for and pleading the case of the entire arts community... The Columbia Orchestra is extremely grateful for your advocacy and financial support, which has not waned throughout this difficult time...”

artRELIEF is just one of the many worthwhile programs the Arts Council spearheaded this year to bring the arts to life in our community. Inside please find our annual report, which recognizes our donors and provides a recap of our activities.

Looking forward, with the help of members and friends—like you—we do see a bright future. Working together, we will continue to rise to the challenge of providing our community with new opportunities for learning, exploration and growth in the arts—please join us.

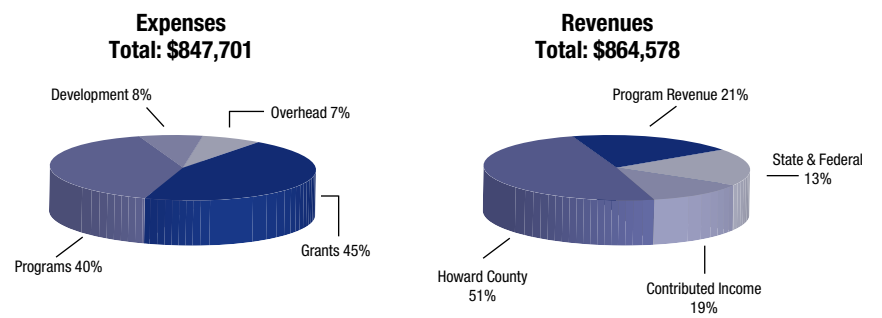
