ARTreach Returns to Long Reach!

June 4, 11am-7pm

WE'RE SO EXCITED for the return of the ARTreach Festival! This free, fun, family festival takes place at Long Reach Village Center and features live performances of world music ranging from Afropop to funk and soul to Latin pop and more. Performers include Everyday Everybody (fka AZTEC SUN), Cheick Hamala Diabate, Cultura Plenera, DOGO du Togo, Ocho de Bastos, and The JoGo Project. Bring a camp chair and pick out a shady space under our tent to enjoy the music-there's even room to get up and dance!

Festivalgoers can also participate in hands-on arts activities: make a tie-dye T-shirt with the Village Center's own Roll Up N Dye; learn traditional pinata-making techniques with the Artesanas of Creative Alliance; create puppets with Beale Street Puppets; immerse yourself in the interactive environment at

DoodleHatch; and more! Ceramics and fused glass artists will demonstrate their crafts inside the Columbia Art Center and there will be tours of the Long Reach Artist Studios throughout the afternoon. You

can also have your caricature drawn, watch as your festival tote bag is screen printed right before your eyes, have your silhouette snipped, commemorate the day at our open-air photobooth, and so much more. Puppet shows, musicians, balloon twisters and other



children's and strolling performers round out the day's free activities.

A one-day pop-up shop at the Columbia Art Center will feature works for sale by participating artists. Food will be available for purchase from Village Center restaurants and our festival food trucks. The first 200 people to bring a non-perishable food donation for the Howard County Food Bank to the festival info tent will receive a free insulated lunch tote. The Long Reach Village Association CARES Committee will hand out free pollinator plants while supplies last.
