Thanks to your generosity, the Arts Council creates an environment where the arts thrive and our community has access to diverse, engaging arts experiences. Each year, with your help, we impact the lives of thousands of people in our community through a wide variety of programs and services. We appreciate all that you do to support our mission and are delighted to share our annual report for fiscal year 2023 with you.

We are extremely proud of our efforts to uplift and advance the arts! Our home, the Howard County Center for the Arts, is a dynamic, community venue in Ellicott City. It is a creative space for artists and the public to make, discover, and experience the arts. Our classes, exhibits, and studio spaces stimulate creativity, conversation, and connections and draw artists as well as art enthusiasts from all over the metro area. The diverse group of studio artists and arts groups that present, practice, and make artwork within our walls create a vibrant space for people to explore the arts. And our year-round educational programs engage students of all ages and abilities in hands-on arts activities. Last year, 28,800 visitors explored our galleries, attended classes, or enjoyed performances in our community black box theatre. These on-site programs were complemented by our outreach efforts that provide fun new ways to experience the arts outside of our walls.

Last vear. we:

- Awarded 57 grants to local and regional arts organizations and K-12 PTAs totaling nearly \$640,000.
- Provided more than \$120,000 to individual artists in the form of scholarships, grants, contracts, and honoraria.
- Recognized exemplary contributions to the arts through Howie Awards to musician & conductor, Michael Blackman (Outstanding Artist); Glenelg High & CCTA theatre teacher, Kassidy Sharp, (Outstanding Arts Educator); arts advocate, Betsy Stark, (Outstanding Arts Supporter); visual artist, Ed Kidera, (Legacy in the Arts, posthumously); and HCPSS Fine Arts Coordinator Gino Molfino (Coleen West Leadership in the Arts).
- Expanded our social media presence and saw tremendous growth in the number of arts events promoted through our online arts calendar.
- Mounted 11 original exhibits that featured 152 artists and 303 K-12 students.
- Organized a four-day plein air event in historic Ellicott City featuring 27 juried artists, 44 community artists and hundreds of spectators.



- Placed 12 new temporary outdoor sculptures at community sites countywide.
- Provided affordable rehearsal, performance, and studio space for 53 artists and arts groups.
- Expanded our community engagement efforts by adding monthly eblasts for Artists Opportunities and Arts Up Close and participating in community tabling events.
- Presented Fabulous 50+ Players musical theatre outreach at senior and community centers.
- Provided hands-on arts experiences to 54 children attending the Ellicott City Head Start Center through our highly acclaimed Head StART in ART artist-in-education program.

All of these efforts resulted in more opportunities for artists and more opportunities for the public to engage in the art.

In addition, the Arts Council Board updated our strategic plan and set priorities for the next five years focusing on:

- Expanding public awareness, financial resources, and advocacy to advance the arts in Howard County
- Building organizational capacity to strengthen the Arts Council's impact
- Increasing and deepening community engagement to strengthen the arts ecosystem
- Evaluating Arts Council programs and services to improve services to artists and audiences

And we continued our tradition of managing our financial resources wisely and ended the year in the black. Of course, we didn't accomplish all of this alone...

Our deepest gratitude goes to County Executive Calvin Ball and Council members Opel Jones, Deb Jung, Christiana Mercer Rigby, Liz Walsh, and David Yungmann for supporting the Arts Council through our Community Service Partnership grant, which is critical to ensuring public access to diverse art forms. Without the leadership of County Executive Ball and the unwavering commitment of the Council, the vibrant arts community we enjoy today would not exist. We thank each one of them for believing in our mission and for recognizing that public funding for the arts is an investment in the quality of life of the people and businesses that grow here.

Our other fundraising efforts were strong. We received a record \$203,899 from the Maryland State Arts Council, along with \$425,000 in state recovery funds – thanks to Governor Wes Moore and our county delegation in Annapolis. The Celebration of the Arts gala, featuring the popular Rising Star competition, raised \$97,000. We received major gifts from: Community Foundation of Howard County, Corporate Office Properties Trust, Ellen Flynn Giles & Ronald Giles, the Isadore and Bertha Gudelsky Family Foundation, Horizon Foundation, The Howard Hughes Corporation, Elizabeth and Ken Lundeen, M&T Bank, SECU, and Sabina Taj & Kyle Reis. And our membership roster topped 332.

## **Grant Programs**

Howard County Arts Council grants are awarded based on artistic merit, ability of the applicant to carry out the project and level of service to the community. Grantees are selected through a competitive process in which applications are reviewed by a volunteer advisory panel made up of academics and artists representing a variety of disciplines. Grant award recommendations are then reviewed and approved by the HCAC Board of Directors. In FY23, HCAC awarded \$637,826.00 in matching grants to 47 organizations.
