Dear Arts Council members and friends,

The past year has been like none we have ever experienced...we are living in unprecedented and challenging times. Many months ago, as we began making our preparations to ride out the COVID-19 pandemic, we came together to support one another and do our part to help 'flatten the curve.' As the County's arts council, we concentrated our efforts on artists and those working in the non-profit arts sector who were dealing with the loss of their livelihoods as galleries, concert halls, and theaters closed.

Like many families and businesses during this public health crisis, the Arts Council Board and staff had to stay at home and take prudent steps to ensure our stability, meet expectations, and preserve what matters. We worked hard to find ways to support the arts in Howard County. Here is a partial listing of our accomplishments. We:

- Distributed \$609,783 in operating and project funds through 65 grants to organizations and over \$60,000 through grants, awards, and fees to individual artists.
- Held 72 camp sessions from June – August 2019, hosting 949 campers, a 20% increase from the previous year and a record high enrollment.
- Opened 16 new studios for artists at the Long Reach Village Center through a new partnership with the County.
- Established the COVID-19 Artist Relief Fund to assist individual artists who lost income from cancelled gigs, contracts, and freelance work as a result of COVID-19 closures.
- Ramped up our social media efforts to keep the arts community informed and connected during the crisis.
- Facilitated the purchase of one of the sculptures from our *ARTsites 2019* public art exhibition, Chris Plaisted's *Door in the Woods*, by Clarksville Commons. This brings the total number of ARTsites sculptures placed permanently in the County to seven.





Exhibits

Paint It! Ellicott City 2019

July 1 – August 9, 2019

An annual *en plein air* painting event and exhibit involving juried artists shown in the gallery and open paint-out community artists shown in the lobby during the opening reception. Presented by Art in Ellicott City in partnership with the Arts Council and Visit Howard County. Juror: Nancy Tankersley, award-winning plein air artist.

Persona

July 1 – August 9, 2019

An exhibit featuring four artists – Oluwatobi Adewumi, Wynston Edun, Charlotte Mann, and Leah Taylor – whose expressive, figurative works broaden the conversation on how portraiture can evoke persona.

Transformations

August 30 – October 11, 2019

Mixed media and installation works by Rachel Borgman, Artemis Herber, Chris Hornsby, and Sunyoung Lee. These artists explore a variety of concepts, but each attributes the process of art-making as integral to their work.

Fragments

August 30 – October 11, 2019

A showcase of photography by local artists Willy Conley, whose self-described 'watergraphs' capture water reflections which are then turned upside-down; and Don James, whose photographs read as abstracts, though they are actually faithful representations of the shape and near-monochrome appearance of his subjects.

Art Howard County 2019

November 1 – December 13, 2019

A biennial, multimedia juried exhibit showcasing Howard County artists. Juror: Robin Holliday, owner and curator of HorseSpirit Arts Gallery.

New Media: Poetry in Motion

November 1 – December 13, 2019

The gallery space was transformed into a screening room to showcase recent video works by Vin Grabill, Brandon Morse, and Joon Sung. These artists experiment with time-based media to create unique works of art that double as visual poems.

HoCo Open 2020

January 10 – February 21, 2020

This annual salon-style, non-juried exhibit featured artwork dropped off within a two-hour period by 141 Howard County artists working in all media.

It Is What It Was

January 10 – February 21, 2020

Deidre Argyle's immersive installation melded fabric cubes, projections, and sound to explore questions about time and repetition, bringing to our attention the cycles by which we are governed: creation, decay, and transformation.

Youth Art Month – Food For Thought: Breaking Bread, Building Community

March 6-14, 2020 & June 20-29, 2020*

An exhibit showcasing artwork in a variety of media and styles by more than 400 K-12 students inspired by the title theme. Part of an ongoing partnership between the Howard

County Arts Council and the Howard County Public School System in celebration of Youth Art Month.

No Boundaries

March 6-14, 2020 & June 20-29, 2020*

An exhibit of artwork by teens and adults with developmental disabilities. Presented in partnership with Howard County Recreation and Parks, Therapeutic Recreation and Inclusion Services and Cedar Lane School.

**Note: Due to the COVID-19 shutdown, these exhibits were suspended shortly after they opened, then resumed when HCCA reopened to the public in June 2020. Exhibits originally scheduled for May-June 2020 were postponed to FY21.*



- Hosted 3 Head StART in ART visiting artist residencies for 162 pre-K children enrolled at the Ellicott City and Old Cedar Lane Head Start Centers.
- Hired a consultant to facilitate joint merger discussions with representatives from Columbia Festival of the Arts, Downtown Columbia Arts and Culture Commission, and Inner Arbor Trust.
- Expanded the resource area of our website to connect artists and the public to important COVID-19 and social justice and equity resources and updates.
- Relaxed matching requirements for FY20 grants and extended deadlines for FY21 applications to help local arts organizations adjust to losses and social distancing requirements due to COVID-19.
- Transformed the Celebration of the Arts in Howard County gala into a virtual event featuring our Rising Star Performing Arts Competition, a guest performance by slam poet Gayle Danley, and an online auction of artwork by local artists; nearly 800 supporters tuned in to the live watch party and subsequent streamed production.
